

TREATY IMPLEMENTATION CELL

The Prime Minister of Pakistan has constituted Treaty Implementation Cell (TIC) to supervise and coordinate the implementation of 27 UN Conventions and Protocols to which Pakistan is a signatory.

3. The Terms of Reference of TIC are as under:-

- i. To oversee the formulation of an effective mechanism in consultation with all Provincial Governments and relevant Federal Ministries/Divisions/Agencies to enable the Provincial Governments as well as the Federal Agencies concerned for effective implementation of the ratified Conventions:
- ii. To develop identical protocols for implementation which can work as effective tools for Provincial and Federal Governments to regularly document the progress made: and,
- iii. To help and guide the Provincial Governments for formulation of templates which can provide for reporting in prescribed and tabulated formats and generation of reports on compliance, in line with international best practices.
