2. The Terms of Reference (ToRs) of the Committee are:

- i. To ensure the smooth implementation of energy projects currently underway or in the pipeline, in particular projects falling under the umbrella of the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor, well within timelines stipulated for these projects;
- ii. Identify and remove bottlenecks in the expeditious implementation of these projects;
- iii. Identify the flaws and deficiencies of the existing legal and institutional framework governing the energy sector and formulate reform initiatives;
- iv. Review the current energy policy and remove its weaknesses;


- v. Formulation of policies/plans on energy conservation and regular/periodical monitoring of such policies/plans; and,
