

Subject: - **Cyber Security Advisory - Zimbra Email Suite Vulnerability Critical Patches (Advisory No. 35)**

Context. Zimbra Email Suite has recently been exposed to an exploit. As per details, Zimbra Collaboration Server (ZCS) allows an attacker to inject memcached commands into a targeted instance which creates arbitrary cached entries.

2. **Vulnerability Details.** CVE-2022-27924 (having score 7.5 as per Common Vulnerability Scoring System) is a command injection flaw in Zimbra Email platform that can lead to the execution of arbitrary memcached commands and theft of sensitive information.

3. **Recommendation.** Administrators of Email Server are advised to update patches from following links: -
