## THE GOVERNOR'S PENSION ORDER, 1974 PRESIDENT'S ORDER NO.3 OF 1974

(as amended upto 13.1.2004)

#### [15<sup>th</sup> October, 1974]

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for the payment of pension to a person who has held the office of Governor;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of Article 101 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the President is pleased to make the following Order, namely:-

(1) This Order may be called the Governor's Pension Order, 1974.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

1.

[(1). There shall be payable to every person who, having held at any time the office of Governor of a Province of Pakistan for not less than two years and not having been removed therefrom for misconduct, has ceased to hold such office a monthly pension \*\*[of ten thousand rupees] for life.

Provided that the right to receive pension under this Order shall be suspended for the period that a person entitled to receive pension holds any office in respect of which he draws salary or other remuneration from the public exchequer:

Provided further that the condition of holding office for not less than two years shall not apply in the case of a person who has held the office of Governor during the period commencing on the twentieth day of December 1971, and ending on the fourteenth day of August, 1973.]

The President may, for special reasons, dir that any period not exceeding one year shall be added a person's service as Governor so as to make up the pid of two years specified in clause (1).

3. In addition to the pension aforesaid, a person referred to in Article 2 shall be entitled to the facilities specified in the Schedule.

4. The expenditure on the pension and other facilities aforesaid shall be charged upon the Provincial Consolidated Fund of the Province concerned \*[or, in the case of a person who held the office of Governor of the province of erstwhile East Pakistan, upon the Federal Consolidated Fund].

#### \*\*[THE SCHEDULE]

#### (See Article 3)

1. Exemption from taking out licences for possessing 3 prohibited bore and 6 nonprohibited bore weapons.

2. Free access to Government Guest Houses, Rest Houses and Circuit Houses in the country.

3. Free installation of telephone at residence and payment of charges for its use up to \*\*\*[Rs.3000] per month.

4. The services of a driver-cum-gunman from the Provincial Police for a period of five years and of a stenographer for a period of four years.

## PRESIDENT'S ORDER NO. 12 OF 2015

### further to amend the Governor's Pension Order, 1974

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Governor's Pension Order, 1974 (P.O. 3 of 1974) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of Article 101 of the Constitution, the President of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan is pleased to make the following Order:-

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Order shall be called the Governor's Pension (Amendment) Order, 2015.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Article 2, P.O. 3 of 1974. – In the Governor's Pension Order, 1974 (P.O. 3 of 1974), in Article 2, in clause (1), for the words "of ten thousand rupees", the words "equivalent to eighty-five percentum of his last drawn monthly salary" shall be substituted.
