DECLARATION OF PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ON THE OCCASION OF ASHURA

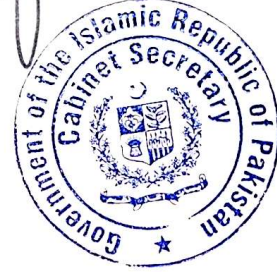


