Subject:- RESIDENTIAL TRIEFHONE AT GOVERNMENT EXPENSES.

The undersigned is directed to invite reference to the Cabinet Division's O.M.No.5/1/70-Coord, dated 9th January 1970 on the above subject. According to which an officer proceeding on leave not exceeding 4 months is allowed to retain his residential telephone at Government expense, and on payment of monthly rent and other expenses if the leave exceeds 4 months. In both cases, the consession is allowed on the prosumption that the officer will either return to the same post on the expiry of leave or will be the Government employ. As this consideration does not apply to the case of an officer proceeding on LPR, the official telephone provided at his residence will be disconnected from the date he proceeds on leave. However, such officers can apply for conversion of their existing residential telephone connections into private ones to the Ministry concerned who will consider such requests on merit, before recommending the same to the telephone Department.
